

## National Ceramic Award for People with Disabilities

### The Artist

#### Who can apply?

The National Ceramic Award is open to all artists with a disability.

Monte Lupo artists are not able to enter works produced at Monte Lupo Arts. Monte Lupo artists can submit works not produced at Monte Lupo Arts and sign a declaration form stating that the works were not produced at Monte Lupo Arts.

#### What kind of works?

Monte Lupo Arts welcomes the submission of all ceramic works.

### The Prize

The judge will nominate two winners of the National Ceramics Award for people with disabilities, Supported and Unsupported. Both winners will each receive the same amount in prize money.

All winning works will be photographed and the images used for publicity for one year after the exhibition. The artist will be credited if the image is used.

### The Application

#### When and how to apply

All entry forms must be forwarded to Monte Lupo Arts by 30 September 2011.

### The Selection

#### Judges

The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

### The Acceptance

#### Dimensions of artworks

Three-dimensional pieces should not exceed 2 metres in height or 2 cubic metres in volume.

### Sale of Artworks

All works must be available for sale and a 30% commission will apply on any sales from the exhibition.

Payments for sold artworks will be made the week following the close of the Exhibition.

### Responsibility of the Artist

Delivery of art works is the responsibility of the artist.

All care will be taken, however Monte Lupo Arts will not be responsible for any loss or damage, howsoever caused. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

### Delivery of Artworks

All artworks should be delivered between the 25 - 30 November 2011.

The Exhibition is from 1 December to 9 December 2011.

The artist is required to make their work available for the duration of the Exhibition period.

#### Collection of artworks

All artists should make arrangements for their artwork to be collected from December 11 2011, unless other arrangements have been made.
