Multicap unveils latest Monte Lupo art

Multicap will unveil its latest art exhibition showcasing the recent works of the organisation's artists with a disability this Tuesday 4 August at Parliament House being opened by the Minister for Disability Services, Annastacia Palaszczuk.

The Little Red and Friends exhibition will run until Sunday 9 August and will include works by Multicap's Monte Lupo artists.

The pieces showcased are based on the individual artist's interpretation of various childhood fairy tales that they investigated. For example, Brett Patzwald" has created wall mosaic mirrors depicting a darker side to Snow White and the seven dwarfs, and Jarrod Went has created a range of Cinderella ceramic dress sculptures.

Multicap Chief Executive Officer Joanne Jessop said the exhibition gave the public a chance to see just how talented the Monte Lupo artists were.

"Our artists have won a number of awards and have their works on display in several galleries and numerous council regions throughout the State," she said.

"We are proud to unveil the Little Red and Friends exhibition, and invite everyone to come over to the exhibition to discover the amazing talents of our artists."
