

Greater Brisbane 3-day lockdown 8 - 11 January 2021

Temporary Impact on Multicap Support and Services

[The Queensland Government has announced a three-day lockdown of Greater Brisbane from 6pm Friday 8 January 2021 until 6pm Monday 11 January 2021.](#)

Residents in the Local Government Areas (LGAs) of **Brisbane, Logan, Ipswich, Moreton, and Redlands** can only leave home for reasons outlined by the Queensland Government in the lockdown directions.

As a result, please note the following changes at Multicap are effective as of 6pm Friday 8 January 2021.

Temporary Suspension of Support and Services

The following Multicap services are cancelled or closed between 6pm Friday 8 January 2021 – 6pm to Monday 11 January 2021. All affected customers are being contacted and advised directly by staff.

Avegates Social Experience Network

Avegates events scheduled for this weekend in these LGAs are now cancelled. These are:

- Karaoke at Aspley and Eight Mile Plains Hubs, Saturday 9 Jan 6pm
- Dreamworld, Sunday 10 Jan 9.30am (Transport from Aspley, EMP, Ipswich and Capalaba Hubs).

Avegates School Holiday Program

Avegates School Holiday Programs in Brisbane North (Geebung) and Redland Bay/Capalaba are cancelled for Monday 11 December.

Monte Lupo Cafés

Monte Lupo Cafés at Eight Mile Plains and Banyo will be closed on Saturday 9 and Monday 11 January.

Community Access Support

All Community Access Support in these LGAs is cancelled.

In-Home Support

In-Home Support services in these LGAs who have informal supports in place are cancelled.

There are amendments to the following Multicap services between 6pm Friday 8 January 2021 – 6pm to Monday 11 January 2021 in line with Queensland Government restrictions.

Accommodation Services

No visitors are permitted at Supported Independent Living, Short Term or Critical Supports accommodation in these areas during this period unless this would have an adverse impact on the customer. Please contact staff at the accommodation service directly for further information.

Community Hubs

Customers and staff attending Community Hubs in these LGAs on Monday 11 January will be required to social distance and wear face masks. Customers will be supported by staff to adhere to these measures, where possible.

Makeables

All employees at Makeables Tingalpa and Rocklea will be required to social distance and wear face masks.
