Michael joined the Multicap Board in February 2017, and was elected to the role of Chair following the retirement of the previous Chair Mr David Eades, in October 2017.

Michael has made a significant contribution to the quality of life of people with disability and their families during his time on the Multicap Board, most recently he formally opened two new fully accessible houses built by Multicap to provide homes for six people living with disability.

Multicap thanks Michael for his contribution to people with disability and we extend our best wishes to him and his family. Mr John Gallimore is now interim Chair until the Board formalises a new appointment.
