FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: MULTICAP CUSTOMER, ONE OF THE FIRST TO RECEIVE NDIS FUNDING IN BRISBANE

Yesterday, Multicap received the news that a Multicap customer is one of the first participants to receive their NDIS plan in the Brisbane region. Most importantly, this customer is being supported to maintain employment, an area that less than 2% of NDIS participants currently have in their plans.

“This is an outstanding outcome for this customer and one we are very proud that we were able to be a part of”, Multicap CEO, Joanne Jessop said.

“One of our dedicated staff members has been working with this customer and their family, from preplanning through to the plan approval and activation stage and was able to assist this customer, one of the first in the Brisbane region, to achieve their goal of maintaining employment”, she added.

Each day we strive to provide people with disability, a safe and supportive environment to live, engage and interact with other customers and the local community. Our community hubs, housing, employment options and support services also give customers access to resources and information to support their needs and aspirations.

With the roll out of the NDIS moving in to the third and biggest year, this is a critical yet exciting time for disability service providers across Queensland. These changes will create opportunities for customers and potential customers that may not have otherwise been possible without the NDIS

“We are proud to continue supporting our customers during this process and we know many of our customers will have their NDIA plans approved over the coming weeks, and with the assistance of Multicap and the NDIS be able to achieve their life goals. This is a very exciting time”, she added.
