THE ACTIVITY

The Centre of Creative Arts (COCA) Painting module is a series of 24 sessions that will assist you to discover your potential as a visual artist in a fun and supportive environment.

These sessions will be offered for 6 hours, one day a week at your Community Hub.

The first 12 weeks is the Painting Primary Elective, where you'll experiment and learn techniques in:

- Acrylic paints
- Watercolour paints
- Themes and design techniques
- Painting on different surfaces
- Completing a canvas painting
- Completing a watercolour painting
- Writing a brief artist bio.

You can then begin a follow-up 12 week Secondary Elective such as Organising a Group Exhibition.

At the end of the 25 weeks you will have:

- Experience working as a team to plan an exhibition
- Taken photos and created a portfolio of work
- Identified locations in the community that can host an exhibition
- Created written descriptions of your work
- Identified potential mentorships with experienced visual artists
- Developed a list of funding opportunities for visual art in Queensland
- Experience in completing grant and other funding applications as a group
- Participated in group showcases and exhibitions.

- Hand-eye co-ordination
- Sensory experiences
- Knowledge of surfaces and mediums
- Experimenting with concept development, imagination and design
- Working as a group /collaborating and communication with others
- Develop confidence/self –expression
