THE ACTIVITY

The Centre of Creative Arts (COCA) Printing module is a series of 24 sessions that will assist you to discover your potential as a visual artist in a fun and supportive environment.

These sessions will be offered for 6 hours one day a week at your Community Hub.

The first 12 weeks is the Printing Primary Elective, where you will experiment and learn techniques in:

- Making stamps with potatoes and other vegetables
- Using stencils
- Basic printing techniques on paper
- Printing on fabric
- Painting motifs on Perspex to create monoprint and print on paper
- Creating screen print design
- Creating screen stencil and attaching to frame
- Printing design onto fabric.

You can then begin a follow-up 12 week Secondary Elective such as organising a Group Exhibition.

At the end of the 25 weeks you will have:

- Experience working as a team to plan an exhibition
- Taken photos and created a portfolio of your work
- Identified locations in your community that can host an exhibition
- Created written descriptions of your work
- Identified potential mentorships with experienced visual artists
- Developed a list of funding opportunities for visual art in Queensland
- Experience in completing grant and other funding applications as a group
- Participated in group showcases and exhibitions.



BENEFITS

- Development of fine motor skills
- Hand-eye coordination
- Sensory experiences
- Knowledge of surfaces and mediums
- Experimenting with concept development, imagination and design
- Working as a group / collaborating and communicating with others
- Confidence/self-expression
