THE ACTIVITY

The Centre of Creative Arts (COCA) Public Art module is a series of 24 sessions that will assist you to discover your potential as a visual artist. Learn how to transform public spaces using art in a fun and supportive environment.

These sessions will be offered for 6 hours, one day a week at your Community Hub. The first 12 weeks is the Public Art Primary Elective where you will experiment and learn techniques to:

- Discover different locations suitable for public art
- Create miniature or dioramas of proposed work
- Explore inspirations/themes for street art
- Experiment with materials and painting techniques
- Create individual sculptural pieces
- Create group installation or murals

You can then begin a follow-up 12 week Secondary Elective such as Setting up a Public Art Team.

At the end of the 25 weeks you will have:

- Experience working as a team to create an end product
- Taken photos and created a portfolio of visual installations
- Identified locations in the community that have public art installations or murals
- Created written descriptions of your work
- Identified potential mentorships with experienced public art workers
- Developed a list of funding opportunities for public art in Queensland
- Experience in completing grant and other funding applications as a group.
